### Auburn Park

Auburn Park is undergoing works to enlarge the park towards Karrabah Road to create an enhanced space that will meet the needs of a growing community. The upgrades include a new basketball court located within Auburn Park, solar light poles, suspended decking, new concrete paths and retaining walls. There will also be shade structures, seating areas, picnic facilities, a drinking fountain and the planting of new trees, shrubs, groundcovers and turf. The upgrades are expected to be completed by April 2025.



#### Bathurst Street Park

The Bathurst Street Park Amenity Building in Greystanes is undergoing a major transformation. The existing building, which is well over 40 years old, is being redeveloped to include two larger storage rooms for sporting groups, an accessible toilet including a baby change table, plus male and female ambulant toilets. There will also be a covered seating area, bubblers and a drink bottle refill station. The works are expected to be completed in May 2025 providing a fresh, new and clean amenities block that is fit for purpose for the growing community.

### Learn to Swim with Active Kids Vouchers

At any age, being able to swim and understand how to be safe in and around water is a necessary life skill.

Did you know that parents, guardians and carers receiving the Family Tax Benefit can apply for an Active Kids voucher for each eligible child. Valued at \$50, the vouchers are available twice a year to use for sport activities, including swimming lessons!

### Publicly Accessible Defibrillators

Residents may have noticed new installations of AEDs (Automated External Defibrillators) across Cumberland over the past few months that are essential for treating sudden cardiac arrest. These portable devices deliver a life-saving shock to restore a normal heart rhythm. Using an AED within the first three minutes of a cardiac arrest can boost survival chances from 5% to 70%.
