## Categories and Criteria



#### 1. Sportperson of the Year:

This award recognises sportspersons in the local community for their outstanding sporting achievements over the past year. The nominee may be an athlete, coach, or official, of any age. Nominees may be recognised for such work as:

- An above and beyond contribution of a club coach or official;
- Sporting excellence achieved by an athlete;
- A consistently excellent attitude and dedication towards sport.
- Fundraising efforts that support good causes in the local community.

#### 2. Environmental Citizen of the Year:

This award recognises individuals and organisations; including schools, community groups, and local businesses that have made an outstanding contribution to the local environment. Nominees may be recognised for work such as:

- Efforts to preserve the environment within their local community;
- Ability to foster partnerships that achieve litter reduction and recycling outcomes; and
- Use of the Return & Earn scheme to help fundraise for a meaningful cause.

#### 3. Young Environmental Citizen of the Year:

The Young Environmental Citizen of the Year Award recognises the next generation of environmental champions. Nominees must be school-aged (primary or secondary) and may be recognised for their contributions to environmental initiatives in their local community. Nominees may be recognised for work such as:

- Efforts that contribute to a sustainable future; and
- Innovate ways to support the environment.

### **Terms and Conditions:**

#### **Nomination**

- Nominations must address the specific criteria.
- Please include as many relevant details about the nominee/s as possible. (A maximum of two additional pages can be added with further information to support your nomination.)
  - 1. A photograph of the nominee/project MUST be attached (in .JPG or .TIFF file format) for use in the Awards Program and Council publications.
  - 2. No school reports, personal documents, certificates etc. are to be submitted. Cumberland City Council staff may contact the nominator for clarification or to obtain further information.
- Each application can nominate ONE nominee and select ONE category. Nominees cannot be nominated for multiple categories.
- Nominators can only nominate ONE nominee per category.

#### Eligibility

- Nominees for individual awards must be an Australian citizen and reside within the Cumberland City Council Local Government Area.
- Where the nominee is a school, group, or organisation, it and its contributions to the community must be based within the Cumberland City Council Local Government Area.
- Nominees may be paid or unpaid workers.
- Nominees may not nominate themselves for an individual category, and must not be nominated by a relative.
- Sitting State and Federal Politicians, as well as Council Staff and Councillors cannot be nominated for these awards.
- Please note, where the nominee is a School, Group, or Organisation, a specific group name is required. For example, "Cumberland Gardening Club" is a defined membership group/organisation and in this case the nomination will be accepted, whereas "Cumberland Gardening Community" is a broad group/organisation name and will not be accepted by the judging panel.

### **Terms and Conditions:**



#### **Process**

- When a nomination is received by Council, nominators shall receive an email from Council acknowledging their submission.
- Council shall appoint a panel to jointly assess each nomination.
- The judging panel shall assess each application on its merits. Repeat applications for the same nominee will not affect the assessment of the panel.
- After the nomination period closes, nominees shall be notified by Council in writing and provided an invitation to the awards ceremony, which shall take place on 26 January 2024.
- The winners of these awards will be invited to participate and represent the Cumberland community at various events and initiatives throughout 2024. The winner of the overall Local Citizen of the Year Award may also be invited to partake in the judging process for the following year.

Nominations for the 2024 awards close Friday 24 November 2023, submissions received after this date will be held over for the 2025 awards.
