PURPOSE

The development of this policy is to provide guidance with regards to the construction, installation and operation of charity collection bins within the Cumberland Local Government Area.

SCOPE

This Policy applies to the Cumberland City Council Local Government Area.

POLICY STATEMENT

This Policy is to control and regulate the placement and management of charity collection bins within the Cumberland City Council Local Government Area.

PRINCIPLES

The purpose of this Policy is to obviate nuisance, minimise the environmental impact and effectively manage safety and public risk from the placement and management of charity collection bins.

REQUIREMENTS

The construction and installation of charity collection bins is prohibited on Council owned or managed (public) land.

The construction and installation of charity collection Bins on private property, must be in accordance with a valid development consent or in accordance with the requirements of Sub - division 10C of the State Environment Planning Policy (Exempt and Compiling Development Codes) 2008.
