Seat Belt Penalties Australian Road Rule - 264-267

Offence type	Paid by	Fine + Demerit Points
Driver not wearing a seat belt	Driver	\$434 + 3DP
1 Passenger not wearing a seat belt		\$434 + 3DP
2 Passengers not wearing a seat belt		\$867 + 6DP
3 Passengers not wearing a seat belt		\$1,397 + 6DP
4 Passengers not wearing a seat belt		\$1,831 + 6DP
Child in unapproved restraint for their age		\$434 + 3DP
Passenger not wearing a seat belt	Passenger (If 16 years+)	\$434
Passenger sharing a seat belt		\$434



Children < 6 months

Require: Rearward facing
restraint



Children 6 months - 4 years

Require: Rear OR forward
facing restraint



Children 4 - 7 years

Require: Forward facing
restraint or booster seat

- Children younger than 4 years cannot travel in the front seat of a vehicle with two or more rows.
- Children aged 4 years to under 7 years cannot travel in the front seat of a vehicle with two or more rows, unless all other back seats are occupied by children younger than 7 years in a child restraint or booster seat.

If a child is not riding in an approved restraint appropriate to their age, you could be fined
\$434 + 3 Demerit Points.
