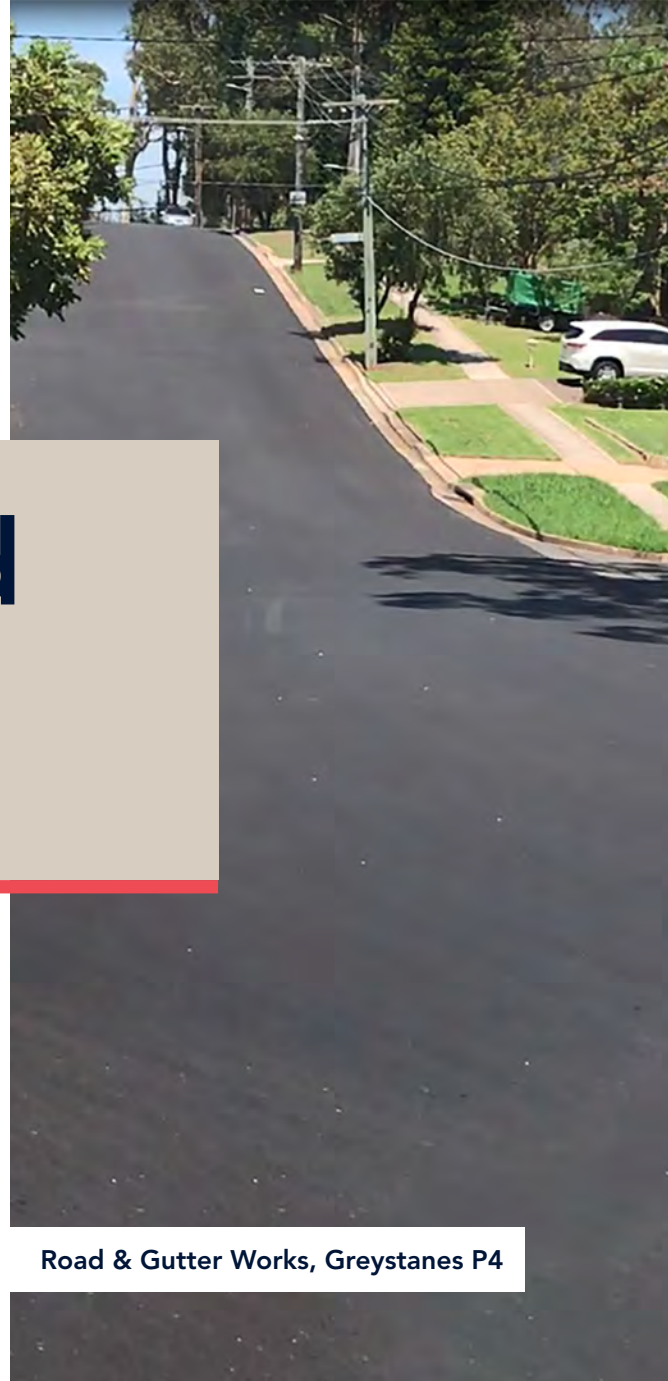
### Greystanes infrastructure works

## Floodlighting upgrade on local sporting fields

---

As part of the Floodlighting Refurbishment Project, Council has upgraded its floodlighting infrastructure across several sporting fields to ensure there is appropriate lighting for games and training events.

The floodlighting upgrade at Fairfield Road Park included the replacement of existing floodlighting systems on the main soccer field with four towers and LED floodlighting units. Tait Street Park's main soccer field and mini field also have floodlighting blocks. The projects were funded by the Parks and Recreation Renewal Program and completed in February 2020.

In May 2020, Cumberland City Council completed Guildford West's McCredie Park Floodlighting Refurbishment Project, funded by the Public Domain Improvement Programme. The project included new LED lighting that connects to a remote operating system.

The lighting upgrade follows Council's Community Strategic Goal - A safe accessible community.



## New playground for children of all abilities

---

Work on the all abilities playground in the Central Gardens at Merrylands West is complete.

The playground includes a hand pump for water play, shade sales, accessible paving and new plantings, with climbing net equipment.
