Maintaining Safe Practices

This means that Council will:

- Remain in line with Public Health advice and NDIS policy and practice framework and guidelines.
- Continue to monitor customer health and infection control by temperature checks and pre program wellness checks.
- Maintain a Seniors & Disability Services COVID Safe Business Plan.
- Keep the display of relevant signage for safeguards (eg 'knowing the signs', 'safe hand washing' and other information at Council facilities).
- Provide you with up to date information where possible via newletters, website/email, facebook, or verbally.
- Ensure all sinks/bathrooms at the facilities have adequate soap/sanitiser and paper towels for safe hand washing.
- Ensure all volunteers/staff have access to the necessary PPE (including hand sanitiser, antibacterial wipes, face masks, gloves to be used when delivering services).
- Notify you if we become aware you are a 'casual contact' or 'close contact' of someone that identifies as having COVID-19. (NB Privacy will need to be maintained so we may not be able to provide the name of person who has the virus).
- We will notify the NDIS Quality & Safeguards Commission of any reportable COVID-19 illness and infection.
- Do all that we can to continue to provide services to you, while ensuring the protection of staff, volunteers and customers at all times.
- Staff will be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 (including booster vaccinations).
- Keep a record of attendance and continue to support social distancing for activities and transport.

We ask you to do the following:

- Ensure you are and remain compliant with requests that is based on NDIS policy and Public Health advice relevant for people with disability in centre based / community-based group service settings.
- Please notify staff immediately if you have illness symptoms, have been a household contact or close contact for a positive case of COVID-19.
- Notify staff if you believe you are at risk of illness or infection.
- Notify staff if you are unwell and self-isolate.
- Please ask staff if you have any concerns or questions around processes and procedures.
- Ensure good hygiene practises.
- Follow good social distancing measures (staying 1.5m apart from people where possible) and wear suitable PPE when necessary / as requested.

Community, Social and Recreational Activities (contribution for unaffordable program activity cost)

This support item is designed to enable providers to claim reimbursement for the costs of enabling a participant to independently engage in community, social and recreational activities when costs of participation exceed an affordable level and without, the participant would be at risk of social isolation. Participants may use this funding for activities such as camps, vacation and outside school hours' care, course, or membership fees. This support item can be delivered to individual participants subject to the rules set out in this Price Guide. This support item is not subject to price limits. It should only be used to recover the costs of the participant's attendance at the community social and participation activities.

Community Participation Activities

This support item is designed to enable providers to claim reimbursement for the costs of tuition fees, art classes, sport coaching and similar activities that build a participant's skills and independence.

Community Participation Cancellation Fee

A short notice cancellation fee is applied when a program support is cancelled by the participant without 7 days' notice. A cancellation fee is as per NDIS Pricing Limits and charged at the 100% of the support line item. A fee free cancellation will apply if a replacement customer from the waitlist is applied and ratio of supports are restored to the correct level. In this case the NDIS charge will be applicable just to the replacement customer.

Community Participation Establishment Fee

As per the NDIS Pricing Limits and Arrangements, this fee is applicable when implementing a participants' first NDIS Plan. Within the agreement Council must supply a minimum of 20hrs per month of service for 3 or more consecutive months.






