#### Eligibility

- Nominees must be an Australian citizen and reside within the Cumberland City Council Local Government Area.
- Nominees may be paid or unpaid workers.
- Nominees may not nominate themselves for an individual category.
- Sitting State and Federal Politicians, Council staff and Councillors are not eligible for nomination.
- Nominees can not be a previous winner.
- Nominee must make every effort to be available to attend the Awards Ceremony in January 2026.

### **Terms and Conditions**

#### **Nomination**

- Nominations must address these terms and conditions.
- Please include as many relevant details about the nominee as possible. (<u>A maximum of two additional pages</u> can be added with further information to support your nomination.)
- Nominators may only nominate ONE nominee and select ONE category on each application form.
   Nominees cannot be nominated for multiple categories.
- Nominators may not submit multiple application forms in an attempt to nominate more than one nominee for the same category.

#### **Process**

- When a nomination is received by Council, nominators shall receive an email from Council acknowledging their submission and the nominee will be contacted to accept their nomination.
- Council shall appoint a judging panel to jointly assess each nomination on its merits.
- Multiple nominations for the same nominee will not affect the assessment of the panel. The decision of the panel is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- After the nomination period closes, nominees shall receive an invitation to the Awards Ceremony where the
  winner of each category will be announced, and shall take place in January 2026. There will be only one winner
  per category.
- The winners of these awards may be invited to participate and represent the Cumberland community at various events and initiatives throughout 2026. The winner of the overall Local Citizen of the Year Award may also be invited to partake in the judging process for the following year.
