Seat Belt Penalties Australian Road Rule - 256-267

| Offence type | Paid by | Fine + Demerit Points |

| Driver not wearing a seat belt | Driver | \$387 + 3DP |
| 1 Passenger not wearing sa eat belt | | \$387 + 3DP |
| 2 Passengers not wearing a seat belt | | \$772 + 6DP |
| 3 Passengers not wearing a seat belt | | \$1,245+ 6DP |
| 4 Passengers not wearing a seat belt | | \$1,632 + 6DP |
| Child in unapproved restraint for their age | | \$387 + 3DP |
| Passenger not wearing a seat belt | Passenger (If 16 years+) | \$387 |
| Passenger sharing a seat belt | | \$387 |



Children < 6 months
Require: Rearward facing
restraint



Children 6 months - 4 years

Require: Rear OR forward

facing restraint



Children 4 - 7 years
Require: Forward facing
restraint or booster seat

- Children younger than 4 years cannot travel in the front seat of a vehicle with two or more rows.
- Children aged 4 years to under 7 years cannot travel in the front seat of a vehicle with two or more rows, unless all other back seats are occupied by children younger than 7 years in a child restraint or booster seat.

If a child is not riding in an approved restraint appropriate to their age, you could be fined \$387 + 3 Demerit Points.
